

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR KIDS OF AFRICA RUN 2024

The event organizers (Kids of Africa) of the **Kids of Africa Run** in Bwerenga/Bugiri (Katabi Town Council, Entebbbe) to be held on 8th September 2024, will take reasonable measures to ensure participants' safety, but shall not be liable for any accidents, injury, loss, or damage arising during the event or on the way to and from the venue.

Participants with known health conditions should consult their doctor prior to taking part in the event. Participants are responsible for their own safety during the event.

Contact person/guardian is responsible for acquiring parental consent for participants below 18 years of age.

Participants must pay full participation fee at the time of application. Participation fee covers registration, water during and after the race, fruit, event vest, and participation certificate. This participation fee is non-refundable regardless of the applicant's ability or inability to attend or complete the race. This participation fee is not transferable to another individual other than the applicant.

Participants are required to provide complete and accurate information in the process of application. Incomplete or inaccurate information may lead to disqualification from participating in the event. The event organizers reserve the right to accept or reject any application without providing a reason.

Winners in the top 3 in the age-categories will be required to produce their National ID or other identification document for birth-year/age verification.

Should you for whatever reason not be able to participate, your participation fee will be considered as a donation.

The Organizers reserve the right to disqualify any person during the "Kids of Africa Run" at any time should the person's physical or mental health and condition, or general attitude and deportment impede the operation of the event and/or affect the welfare and enjoyment of the other participants. Likewise, any malpractice, including but not limited to shortcuts, obstructions, change of starting number, or ignoring the instructions of the police and race marshals may lead to immediate disqualification.

The Ugandan traffic laws apply. The participants must follow the instructions of the police and race marshals.

It is the responsibility of each participant in the bicycle category during the event to wear an approved helmet and to use a fully functional and approved bicycle. Malfunctioning bicycles are not permitted. The bicycle course is partly on uneven ground with gravel, marram, or asphalt surface, overall best suitable for a mountain-bike type bicycle. Electrical bicycles are not permitted.

By participating in the event, the participant grants the event organizers permission to 1) use photographs, videos or recordings, which may contain the participant's likeness for promotional and/or advertising purposes, and 2) the phone number of each participant for sending relevant event information to the owner.

By participating in "Kids of Africa Run", each participant automatically declares that he/she has read and understood the above listed terms and conditions, and have a clear understanding of the "Kids of Africa Run" in which he/she is about to participate.

Each participant also declares that he/she realizes that the event along gravel/marram/asphalt roads in Bugiri and Bwerenga holds an inherent risk for injuries and partake based on that understanding. In addition, each participant understands that any expenses resulting from treatment of any injury, as well as replacement/compensation from any damaged materials, before, during, or after the event will be at his/her own expense and not at the expense of the organizer. Any disputes arising from this agreement will be referred to arbitration and determined under the laws of Uganda.

IMPORTANT NOTE ON AGE-CATEGORIES:

Your **birth-year** determines in which **age-category** you participate!

Example:

If you are born on 1st December 2006 (which makes you 17 years on the day of the event) you compete in the **18-34 years age-category** as you later in the year will turn 18 years.

10 km run

Overall top 3 finishers in male and female categories: 1st: trophy + UGX300.000, 2nd: trophy + UGX200.000, 3rd: trophy + UGX100.000

Winners of age categories in male and female categories: 1st: UGX80.000, 2nd: UGX50.000, 3rd: UGX30.000 for each category

All that finish the race will receive a participation medal

21 km run

Overall top 3 finishers in male and female categories: 1st: trophy + UGX300.000, 2nd: trophy + UGX200.000, 3rd: trophy + UGX100.000

Winners of age categories in male and female categories: 1st: UGX80.000, 2nd: UGX50.000, 3rd: UGX30.000 for each category

All that finish the race will receive a participation medal

21 km bicycle
